ORDINANCE NO. 348

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING ORDINANCE NO. 198, SECTION 16, STORAGE WAREHOUSES, BY ADDING TO THE CATEGORY OF MINI-WAREHOUSES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mexico Beach, Florida, has determined that it is in the best interest of the people of Mexico Beach that the category of occupational licensing for mini-warehouses be amended, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA:

 $\underline{\text{Section 1}}.$ Add the following to Ordinance No. 198, Section 16 (a), Page 14:

(a) Mini-warehouse (0-10 units), per unit, per year......\$ 6.00 Mini-warehouse (11 units and above), per year.....\$62.50

 $\underline{\text{Section 2}}$. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
