

NOTICE TO RECEIVE SEALED BIDS

The City of Mexico Beach will receive sealed bids from any qualified person, company or corporation interested in constructing:

CITY OF MEXICO BEACH WELCOME CENTER

This project includes construction of a new Welcome Center Building (approximately 1,200 SF), sidewalks, pavement and parking striping, signage, and connections to existing utilities.

The bid must conform to Section 287.133(3) Florida Statutes, on public entity crimes. Cost for Plans and Specifications will be \$25.00 per set and is non-refundable. The completion date for this project will be 150 days for Substantial Completion and 180 days for Final Completion from the date of the Notice to Proceed presented to the successful bidder. Liquidated damages for failure to complete the project on the specified date will be set at \$200.00 per day.

The City of Mexico Beach reserves the right to waive informalities in any bid, to accept and/or reject any or all bids, and to accept the bid that in their judgment will be in their best interest. All bids shall remain firm for a period of ninety (90) days after the opening. The awarding by the City Council will be held on July 14, 2020, however, the City reserves the right to withhold Notice to Proceed for up to 90 days.
