

NOTICE TO RECEIVE SEALED BIDS THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH- SCBA Air Compressor, Fill Station.

The City of Mexico Beach hereby advertises for the proposed purchase of one (1) Air Compressor, Fill Station for Mexico Beach Fire Department. The breathing air station shall be comprised in part, of a high-pressure compressor and purification system, storage system, cascade fill control panel and containment fill station and shall strictly adhere to the following specifications:

1. Meet ISO 9000:2015
2. 6000 PSI Service
3. 2 SCBA Fill Stations for SCBA Bottles
4. 4 DOT Air Storage Tanks at 6000 PSI
5. Delivery and Installation
6. Training on Operation of Unit

Proposal Submission must meet the following requirements:

1. Bids will be received until 2:00 P.M. Central Time on January 6th 2020, and will be opened and read publicly at 2:05 P.M. at the City Hall, located at 201 Paradise Path, Mexico Beach, Florida, 32456. All bids shall be sealed and clearly marked SCBA Air Compressor, Fill Station Bid. Attn: City Clerk. The City will not be responsible for bids opened in error, which are incorrectly or inadequately marked.
2. Submission of a proposal indicates acceptance by the bidder of the conditions contained in this request for proposals (collectively "Proposal[s]"), unless clearly and specifically noted in the proposal submitted and confirmed in the contract between the City Mexico Beach and the bidder selected.
3. All Bids must be in writing and submitted as one (1) original and Five (5) signed copies. The original response shall contain the original signature of the authorized person signing the proposal. Failure to include the original and all signed copies may be grounds for rejection of your proposal without further evaluation.
4. All Bids shall be submitted in an envelope clearly marked "Sealed Bid-Mexico Beach Fire Rescue- "Fire and Rescue SCBA System." All information and submittals requested shall be in hardcopy form and included in the Proposal. Proposals shall not refer the City to electronic media such as websites in order to obtain required information or submittals. (is this paragraph needed?)
5. All Bids shall be firm for a period of Ninety 90 days after opening. Selection Criteria: The City shall award the purchase order to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; provided, however, the City reserves the right to award the Contract to a Bidder who is not the lowest responsive and responsible bidder if the City determines in its reasonable discretion that another Bid offers the City a better value based upon the reliability, quality of service, or product of such other Bidder. The City will be the final authority in deeming compliance with the specifications.

The City reserves the right to (1) reject any and all Proposals, (2) to waive any informality in bids received, or (3) to award the contract to a bidder other than the lowest bidder should it find that the lowest bidder does not offer the reliability, quality of service or product afforded by such other bidder. Where a bid other than the lowest bid is taken, the City Council will state the reasons upon which such

award was made. All bidders shall comply with all applicable state and local laws concerning licensing, registration, and regulations of businesses in the state of Florida. For information and /or specifications, contact Fire Chief Donald Walker:
