To all bidders: Please note that an Addendum Acknowledgement form is listed as a Required Additional Form in the RFP under Item 8 of the Submittals.

Question: Page 40 of RFP reads debris shall be disposed of in an upland site permitted by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) (or applicable state agency) for C & D (Construction and Demolition) disposal. Should this also include vegetation?

City Response: Yes, debris should be transported and appropriately disposed of in an upland site, permitted by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) or applicable stage agency for C & D (Construction and Demolition) disposal and vegetation processing and disposal.

Question: Is the City allowing Hand Loading Crews?

City Response: As described in the RFP Hand Loading Crews will be allowed.

Question: What is the minimum bond?

Response: The RFP requires a \$50,000 proposal bond. The construction bonds, per the RFP, are required for each disaster event based on its size/scope.

Question: Should there be a separate unit price in Price Schedule for Car & Truck Removal from water way and for boat removal from water way?

Response: A separate unit price line has been added to the Price Schedule for Car & Truck Removal from water way and for boat removal from water way.

Question: Scope of work states "Demo and Move to R.O.W", however, the Price Schedule states "Demo and Haul to Final Disposal." Which is correct?

Response: The Price Schedule has been revised to clarify that all debris shall be transported to an FDEP permitted DDMS site or a state Designated Final Disposal Site. All debris, including debris resulting from demolition work performed by contractor shall be transported to an FDEP permitted DDM site or a state Designated Final Disposal Site (per the Price Schedule).

Question: Should Price Schedule have a line item for Staging and Separation of C & D and Load Out to Final Destination?

Response: The RFP does not have a separate item for Staging and Separation of C & D and Haul-out to final destination.

Question: Should Price Schedule include two separate line items for Vegetation and one for C & D under the Haul-out?

Response: The Price Schedule has been revised to reflect two separate line items for Haul-out, one for C & D and a line item for Vegetation Haul-out.
