STORMWATER INSPECTION AND CLEANING

This project includes the video inspection and cleaning of approximately 15,000 linear foot of 12"-24" pipe, 4,100 linear foot of 48" pipe and 2,750 linear foot of 8'x3' box culvert.

The bid must conform to Section 287.133(3) Florida Statutes, on public entity crimes. Cost for Plans and Specifications will be \$25.00 per set and is non-refundable. The completion date for this project will be 60 days for Substantial Completion and 90 days for Final Completion from the date of the Notice to Proceed presented to the successful bidder. Liquidated damages for failure to complete the project on the specified date will be set at \$200.00 per day.
