It is fully understood that this Agreement does not create an obligation to perform sediment or debris clearance. The undersigned understands and acknowledges that dredging work poses some risk of damage to nearby vessels and property owned by the undersigned and others, but the undersigned has decided that the benefits of expanded and more complete dredging adjacent to the undersigned's property outweighs these risks of damage. The undersigned agrees and warrants to hold harmless the City of Mexico Beach, their agencies, contractors and subcontractors, for damage of any type, whatsoever, either to the above described property, in-water works (seawalls, boat slips, etc), vessels or persons situated thereon and hereby release, discharge and waive any action, either legal or equitable which might arise out of any activities on the above-described property or in the canal adjacent to such property.
