Mayor Bailey called the Special Meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

1. Special Election Ratification- City Clerk

Ordinance 664

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA; PROHIBITING OBSTRUCTIONS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LEFT ON THE PUBLIC BEACHES OF THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH, FLORIDA BETWEEN 7PM AND 7AM DAILY, AND TO BE COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS “THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH LEAVE NO TRACE ORDINANCE;’ FOR SAID POLICIES TO AMEND, BE CODIFIED AND BECOME PART OF THE CITY OF MEXICO BEACH LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS (LDR); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND MODIFICATIONS THAT MAY ARISE FROM CONSIDERATION AT PUBLIC HEARING; AND, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

- a. Motion by Mr. Putnal and seconded by Mrs. Albrecht to read Ordinance 664.
- b. Motion by Mrs. Albrecht and seconded by Mr. Wallace to adopt Ordinance 664 and instruct the City Clerk to certify to the Secretary of State by March 3, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

2. Leave No Trace Implementation- Mayor


Mayor Bailey began discussion on the steps of implementation of the newly adopted Leave No Trace Ordinance. Discussion ensued on the marketing and enforcement expenses. Discussion of beach patrol also was addressed and the council is considering bringing back beach patrol. Coastal Parasail was present to discuss how they handle enforcement and cleanup in the rest of the county. Coastal Parasail will send an estimate to the City tomorrow to show the costs to provide these services to the county. Council will continue to look at options and begin the implementation process. The Ordinance is effective beginning March 1 and enforcement will begin with implementation.

3. Fish Cleaning Stations- Mayor

Mayor Bailey brought up discussion on the fish cleaning stations and an idea to use a refrigeration unit for the storage of fish carcasses and daily disposal by the City. Discussion ensued. Council instructed staff to reach out to the St Joe company for their blessing.
